## BATCH, FIND OUT HOW OLD A PRODUCT IS

Find out how old the product is by looking at the batch number which is placed inside the torch or battery pack of a headlamp. Here below is a short definition of Suprabeam Batch numbers, first letter is year and second letter is month, here are some exsamples:


AE = (A)2010 -(E)05 BA = (B)2011 - (A)01 CD = (C)2012 - (D)04 DG = (D)2013 - (G)07






## OBSTRUCTED LIGHT BEAM

The Q3defend has a cover filter to protect the lens. It is possible that this filter may become damaged or scratched, which will be visible on the light beam. In this case, it may necessary to replace the filter:



## SEALING THE FLASHLIGHT

The Q3defend has covers that make it dust and water resistant. Please make sure that these areas are clean and closed tight:

- 1) Remove the strike bezel and the scalloped cap
- 2) Make sure the flashlight is clean and dry. Check for possible damaged parts to be replaced.









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
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

- 1) The short side of the cable will be connected to the battery pack. The long side of the cable will be connected to the headlamp.
- 2) To avoid damaging the pins make sure to bring the cable as straight as possible to the port.
- 3) Connect the cable firmly, you may hear a light "click" when doing so.





## MOUNTING THE HEADLAMP ON THE BAND








# MOUNTING THE BATTERY PACK ON THE BAND






#### PROBLEMS WITH THE FOCUS

When it gets very difficult to use the focus, most of the time it is caused by insufficient cleaning. Make sure that the flashlight is clean around the area of the focus. Use a damp cloth to clean it.


- 1) Slide the head out to open the focus.
- 2) Make sure that the flashlight is clean, particularly around the highlighted area.



#### UNABLE TO ADJUST THE ANGLE

When it gets difficult to change the angle of the head, most of the time it is caused by insufficient cleaning. Please check that the head of the headlamp is clean:


- 1) Rotate the head of the lamp to open it.

Make sure that the security tape of the battery has been removed.




#### **BATTERY**



#### **DAMAGED CABLE**


Check for any visible damages on the cable. If any, replace the cable.



## REPLACING THE CABLE

- 2) To avoid damaging the pins make sure to bring the cable as straight as possible to the port.
- 3) Connect the cable firmly, you may hear a light "click" when doing so.


